

GUARDIAN'S ACCEPTANCE OF MINOR'S GUARDIANSHIP

When the legal parent has only a Mexican ID or passport, the guardian must hold a valid USA ID to accept the agreement. If the parent has only a Mexican ID or passport, a third-party Credible Witness with a valid USA ID is needed. A credible witness is not required if the legal parent has a valid USA ID.

This entails the necessary authority and capability to provide all essential care and services outlined in this agreement, without any restrictions. I acknowledge and agree that this arrangement is of a temporary nature, lasting no more than 365 days (1 year) from the date of my signature below. After this duration, a new agreement may be considered. I acknowledge that this agreement can be terminated at any time by any adult mentioned in this agreement by presenting the other adult(s) within this document with a notarized written termination request.
